1989 to 1997 Driver split screen Morris Minor pre 1957 Classic saloons UK

1994 & 1995 Team manager Ford Mondeo BTCC team, UK Andy Rouse's Ford touring car programme

1980 Team manager Cuda Formula Atlantic

1973 Construction with Adrian Reynard, the Reynard 73FF Formula Ford, Sabre Automotive, which became Reynard Racing cars.

1970 Driver March 708 Formula Ford, modified the March Chassis nick names "Starch (Stone-March).

1969 Building jigs, chassis and cars, the first March car 693 Formula 3 UK

1968 Driver Brabham BT18 Brands Hatch Formula 3 (probably the first F3 car to use a wing.

1967 & 1968 Driver Brabham BT6 NZ Gold Star Championship Series.

1967 & 1968 Driver Brabham BT6 NZ Grand Prix.

1965 & 1966 - Driver – Cooper T52 – New Zealand Grand Prix 1965 & 1966 competing against the likes of Graham Hill and Jackie Stewart.

1964 ex-Denny Hulme Cooper T52 in Formula Junior.
