An elegant wine, full of charm!  Well-known owner of Graves (Vieux Château Gaubert, Grand Bourdieu, Haut-Pommarède), where he operates a hundred hectares, Dominique Haverlan has expanded into pessac-Léognan with the acquisition in 2004 of Ch. Civrac-Lagrange and by Ch. Pontet-Caillou.  The opinion of the Guide Hachette des Vins The intense color suggests a wine of character. On the bouquet, the aging imposes powerful vanilla and roasted notes (coffee), revealing aromas of ripe black fruits.
